In December we installed a water treatment system in our senior citizens residence. The system has been running for six months by now and we are very pleased with the results.

We have a total of 478 water outlets in the building (289 facuets, 97 toilets, 92 showers). When checking the faucet outlets and showers we no longer find the typical scale build up or blockages. We have an indoor swimming pool which we use for all medical therapies. In this area we are also fully content with the effect of the water treatment.

For facilities for elderly people like ours it is inevitable to use water treatment that functions without chemicals or additional salt. We face an annual water consumption of 12.000 m³ where a chemical system would cause tremendous costs and maintenance work for us. Compared to that, the annual costs of the water treatment system – which has been working without any malfunction and functions without any mainteneance work.
